

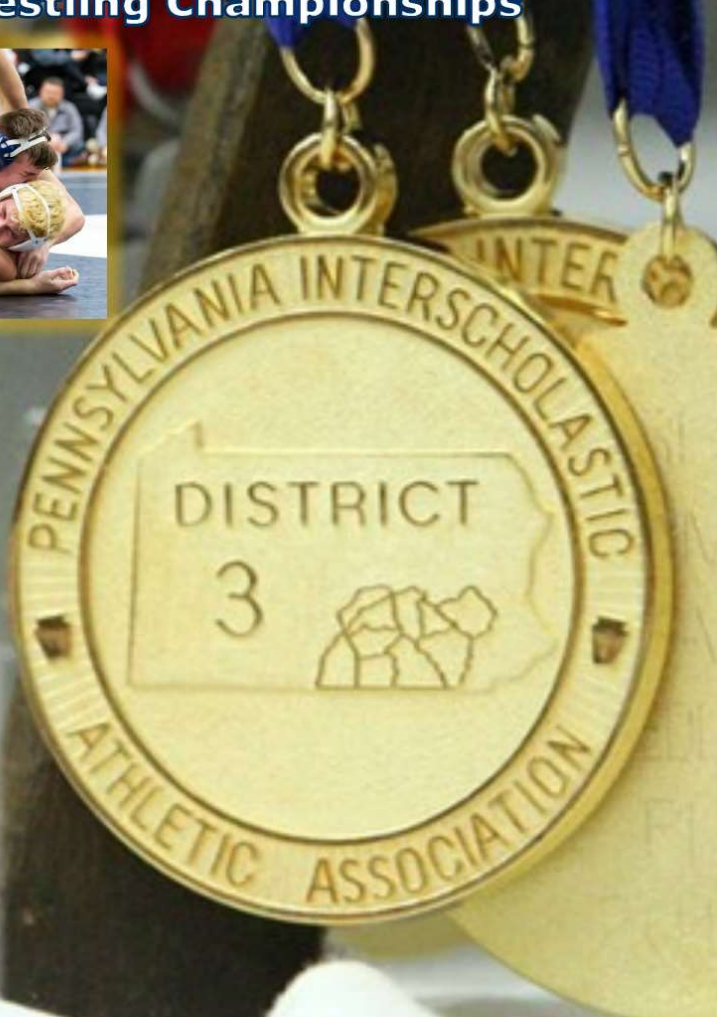

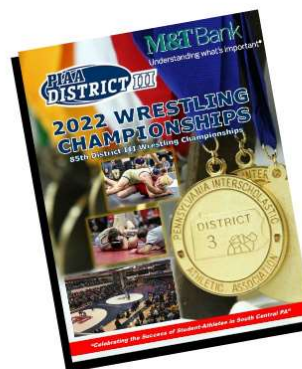

## PIAA DISTRICT III

The state of Pennsylvania is divided in 12 geographic districts for PIAA administrative purposes. Each district has a district committee elected by member schools from within that District. Every committee elects a chairperson who becomes that District's representative on the PIAA Board of Directors. District III has an additional representative on the State Board based on the number of members schools. District I and District XII also have an additional representative; District VII has two additional representatives.

District III encompasses the counties of Adams, Berks, Cumberland, Dauphin, Franklin, Juniata, Lancaster, Lebanon, Perry and York. Within this 10 county-area are 125 member senior high schools.

These member schools elect their District Committee to oversee various interscholastic programs within the District. While the District Committee must follow all PIAA rules and regulations, each district has autonomy in administering athletic contests prior to the PIAA interdistrict level.

District III is home to the following leagues Berks County Interscholastic Athletic Association, Christian Commonwealth Athletic Conference, Lancaster-Lebanon League, Mid-Penn Conference, Tri-Valley League and York-Adams Interscholastic Athletic Association. A small number of schools retain independent status.

The voting rules of the District mandate that all leagues shall have at least one representative on the Committee as a voting member. These representatives are elected by the members schools at an Annual Meeting held each April. In addition, a representative from the Pennsylvania School Board Association, a male officials' representative, a female officials' representative, a male and female parents' representative and a girls athletics representative stand as voting members of the District III committee. There are 16 voting members plus 7 non-voting members on the Committee.

The District Committee develops, organizes and directs 26 District III championships (13 for boys, 13 for girls) in 16 different sports. Broken down by gender and class, the District conducts 71 team championships and 30 individual championships. Among the 30 individual championships, the District crowns 168 champions each year.

These championships are a prerequisite to qualification for PIAA championships. In the fall, these include boys and girls cross country, field hockey, boys and girls golf, football, boys and girls soccer, girls tennis and girls volleyball. In the winter, championships conducted are boys and girls basketball, boys and girls swimming & diving, wrestling and competitive spirit. While there is no PIAA championship for bowling, District III does conduct an individual championship for boys and girls bowling. The spring championships are baseball, boys and girls lacrosse, softball, boys and girls outdoor track and field, boys tennis and boys volleyball.

The complete cost of funding these championships comes from the spectator ticket admission fees at District III playoff events. This money is used to fund sports at which no admission fee is charged and where the cost exceeds the income, insurance and administrative costs. At the end of each school year, surplus funds are returned to the schools that participated in the sports that created the surplus. Schools do not pay District dues or provide money to the District in any form with the exception of an entry fee in golf, tennis, competitive spirit and bowling.

### OUR MISSION

- ◆ Organize, develop and direct athletic programs that will promote the health and physical welfare of all participants, both male and female.
- ◆ Foster good sportsmanship and safeguard the educational values of interscholastic athletics.
- ◆ Develop and enforce rules adopted by the member schools that regulate interscholastic athletic competition.
- ◆ Organize and conduct a program of District III championship tournaments in various fields of athletic competition .

### REMEMBERING MR. WENDELL HOWER



The District III community mourns the recent passing of Mr. Wendell Hower, a long-time member and former executive director/secretary of the District III Committee. Mr. Hower devoted his life to his community and education. A graduate of Franklin & Marshall, where he played on the school's first undefeated football team and is enshrined in its Hall of Fame, he began his career as a math teacher at Manheim Township High School. During this time, he coached and was a PIAA official in football, basketball and baseball. He went on to serve Manheim Township as assistant principal and athletic director before being named principal, a position he held for nearly 30 years before retiring in 1996. His tenure on the District III committee began as a Lancaster-Lebanon League representative in 1973. In 1997, he was elected Executive Director/Secretary, a position he held until 2019. Mr. Hower also served as president on the Lititz Borough Council and spent 8 years on the Warwick School Board. We are thankful for Wendell's guidance and friendship over the many years. Our condolences to his family and friends.

# DISTRICT III WRESTLING HALL OF FAME Class of 2022

## Duane Bastress

Inducted as a wrestler and coach. Duane is a 2001 graduate of Bermudian Springs and a graduate of York College of Pennsylvania where he received a Bachelor of Science degree in therapeutic recreation and leisure in 2006.

Duane finished his high school wrestling career with 85 wins. He placed third in the 2000 District III tournament, was the Southwest Regional Runner-Up and qualified for States. In 2001, he was the Mid-Penn conference and Sectional champion, and placed third at the district tournament. Duane's college career ended with a 114-21 record. He was the Division III National Champion at 184 lbs. in 2005 and 2006. In 2006, he was named the Division III Most Outstanding Wrestler with a 40-0 record. He capped his career with a 65 match winning streak. Duane was a three-time Division III national qualifier, three-time Metropolitan conference finalist and two-time Metropolitan conference champion. He was the Metropolitan Conference Most Outstanding Wrestler in 2006 and helped lead his team to a 5th place finish at the National Division III championships.

Duane has posted a 100-45 record coaching the York College of Pennsylvania wrestling program. He was named the Assistant Coach of the Year by the Metropolitan Conference and the NWCA Division III in 2012. In 2019, he was named the Division III Southeast Regional Coach of the Year. Duane has coached 27 Scholar All Americans, 16 Division III National qualifiers, 6 Division III All Americans including one four-time All American, and 12 conference champions. Duane has been inducted into the NWCA Division III Hall of Fame (2013), the York College Athletics Hall of Fame (2016), the Adams County Sports Hall of Fame (2018).

Duane resides in Dover, PA with his wife April and their three children (Cora, Audrey, and Drake). He is the York College of Pennsylvania's Head Men's and Women's Wrestling Coach and Head Strength and Conditioning Coach.

Inducted as a wrestler. Cory is a 2008 graduate of Littlestown High School and a graduate of the University of Pennsylvania where he received a Bachelor of Arts degree in criminology in 2012.

Cory finished his high school wrestling career with a record of 143 wins and 26 losses, with 71 pins. He was a four-time District III place winner. Cory was the 2007 PIAA AA state champion at 171 lbs. He is Littlestown High School's only state champion. Cory was a two-time letter winner for Penn and started at 189 lbs. his sophomore year. He placed 4th at East Stroudsburg Open tournament and fourth at the Keystone Classic. Cory's college career was shortened by injury.

Cory resides in Frederick, MD and is employed as an air traffic controller with the Federal Aviation Administration at the Washington, D.C. Air Route Traffic Control Center.

## Billy Chamberlain

Inducted as a wrestler. Billy is a 2006 graduate of Cumberland Valley High School and a graduate of Duquesne University where he received a Bachelor of Arts degree in history in 2010. He received his teaching certificate from Wilson College in 2013.

Billy finished his high school wrestling career with 110 wins and 20 losses. He was a two-time District III finalist and District champion in 2006. He qualified for the PIAA state tournament twice and was the PIAA AAA state champion in 2006. He was a two-time Fargo All American and Fila Junior All-American. In college, Billy posted a 50-34 record. He was a NCAA national qualifier in 2009 and three-time University National All-American.

In four years as head coach at Manheim Central High School, Billy's record was 40 – 25 with two Lancaster-Lebanon League championships. He coached one PIAA AAA individual state champion. ## Corey Houser

Inducted as a wrestler. Corey is a 2007 graduate of Governor Mifflin High School.

Corey started wrestling in 6th grade after signing up for wrestling at the Ephrata YMCA with the goal of becoming the next Stone Cold Steve Austin or Hulk Hogan. During tournaments, surrounded by classmates wearing Governor Mifflin singlets, he realized wrestling was a scholastic sport like football and baseball. Walter finished his high school wrestling career with 172 wins and 13 losses. He served as Central Dauphin's team captain for three years. He was the District III champion in 2005, finished 2nd in 2006 and 2007 and third in 2008. Walter medaled four times at the PIAA AAA state tournament, finishing 3rd, 2nd, 1st and 2nd. Walter was the 2007 PIAA AAA state champion at 135 lbs. He was a two-time Powerade champion, a Beast of the East finalist, and two-time Super 32 finalist. He was a USA Wrestling Junior Nationals All American and was selected for the Dapper Dan Team PA. He was ranked as high as second nationally by Wrestling USA Magazine. In college, Walter's record was 111-42. He posted the fifth highest wins in Harvard wrestling history, and his 31 falls rank him third in school history. He was a two-time NCAA Division I All-American, placing 8th in 2011 and 2012. He was a two-time EIWA finalist and three-time place winner. Larry was an outstanding wrestler in high school and went on to share his passion for the sport as a coach. Larry posted a record of 272 wins, 138 losses and two ties as head coach at Oley Valley High School from 1969 to 1997. During that time, he coached 25 PIAA state qualifiers, six District III champions, and four PIAA state place winners. His teams won eight division championships and were the 1990-1991 Berks County champions. The Oley Valley matches against Brandywine Heights with long-time coach, the late Sam Lovello, were held in sold out gyms with overflow crowds watching from the cafeteria on closed circuit television. Later, to accommodate more fans, the matches were moved to Kutztown University. Larry was the Tulpehocken Junior High head coach and proudly coached his grandchildren in the Tulpehocken elementary program. Larry was also proud his sons-in-law Brynn and Keegan helped coach the grandsons in wrestling. Larry was inducted into the Berks County Hall of Fame and the Pennsylvania Sports Hall of Fame in 2018.

Sadly, Larry passed away March 24, 2020. He is survived by his wife of 51 years, Marge and their two daughters, Jenel and Erika and their husbands Brynn and Keegan, as well as five grandsons who wrestle, Abram, Caleb, Rhys, Jayce, and Channing Schaffer and four granddaughters, Havyn, Eliana, Yarow, and Evi Schaffer.

## In Memoriam

In the past two years, we have lost seven members of the District III Wrestling Coaches Association Hall of Fame as well as two notables associated with District III wrestling. In honor of these men and their many outstanding contributions to District III wrestling, a moment of silence will be observed at this year's Championships.



### RALPH BYERS

Ralph Byers, 75, was born in Lancaster on April 8, 1944, and passed away in Carlisle on March 16, 2020. Ralph was an outstanding wrestling official for 27 years and served as a coach on several teams in the Carlisle Area School District, where he was a health and physical education teacher for many years. He was a member of the following Halls of Fame: District III Wrestling Coaches (1997), PA Chapter of the National Wrestling HOF (2011), Penn Manor Wall of Honor (2014). He was a graduate of Penn Manor HS and West Chester University and earned his Master's Degree in Secondary Education from Shippensburg University.



### DAVE CONAWAY

Dave Conaway, 63, was born on December 25, 1957, and passed away on July 4, 2021. Dave served as head wrestling coach at New Oxford High School for 22 years after 7 seasons as an assistant wrestling coach at the school. His son, Jordan Conaway, is the school's lone PIAA champion and a 2-time NCAA All-American at Penn State. He is a member of both the District III Wrestling Coaches Association Hall of Fame and the New Oxford Athletic Hall of fame. He was a graduate of Philipsburg-Osceola HS and Clarion University.



### JOHN "JD" DUNSMORE

John Dunsmore, 85, was born in Philipsburg in 1935 and passed away in Camp Hill on September 18, 2020. John was a physical education teacher in the Big Spring School District for 35 year and coached wrestling for 30 years, amassing 302 victories for the Bulldogs. He is a member of the District III Wrestling Coaches Hall of Fame and the West Shore Chapter of the PA Sports Hall of Fame. He was a graduate of Philipsburg High School, where he did not participate in wrestling, and Lock Haven University.



### GLENN FLEGAL

Glenn Flegal, 88, was born in Clearfield on October 25, 1931, and passed away in Mechanicsburg on December 27, 2020. Glenn was an accomplished wrestler (PIAA runner-up in 1950 at Clearfield), coach (started the Carlisle program) and official (noted for his colorful mat slap of a pin and his scrupulous fairness). He is a member of the District III and PA Wrestling Coaches Halls of Fame as well as the PA Chapter of the National Wrestling HOF. He was a graduate of Millersville University as well as Clearfield High School.



### RAY E. "SKIP" HUTTER, JR

Skip Hutter, 88, was born in Harrisburg on October 13, 1932 and passed away in Mechanicsburg on August 22, 2021. Skip covered a very wide range of sports. He had a big impact on scholastic wrestling with his coverage in The Patriot-News, including his popular Big 12 feature. He is an inductee of several Halls of Fame, including the District III and PA Wrestling Coaches and the West Shore Chapter of the PA Sports Hall of Fame.



### MIKE KHAN

Mike Khan, 42, was born on September 17, 1978 and passed away on May 15, 2021, the result of a motorcycle accident. Mike was an outstanding wrestler at Harrisburg HS, winning a pair of PIAA championships and a national freestyle title among other honors. He was a 3-time District III wrestling champion and a member of the District III Wrestling Coaches Association Hall of Fame.



### ED MICHAEL

Ed Michael, 67, was born October 21, 1954 and passed away on November 14, 2021. He wrestled at Lower Dauphin HS. Ed was a lifelong fan of high school wrestling and was encyclopedic in his knowledge. But where Ed stood out was his enduring commitment to hands-on work for the District III and PIAA tournaments, doing tasks that greatly aided those events. It is with gratitude that District III acknowledges Ed's selfless commitment to the sport.



### NEIL TURNER

Neil W. Turner, 83, was born in Clearfield on November 26, 1938 and passed away in Lancaster on December 30, 2021. While not a head coach at District III high school, Neil nonetheless had significant impact with District III wrestlers and coaches during his time as head coach at Messiah University and his countless clinics in the District III area. He is a member of numerous Halls of Fame, including the PA Chapter of the National Wrestling Hall of Fame. He was a Clearfield HS and Penn State University grad.



### KEN WHISLER

Ken Whisler, 85, was born in Hummelstown on July 22, 1934 and passed away on March 23, 2020, at his Hummelstown home. Ken was an outstanding wrestling coach at Newport HS and Manheim Township HS in Neffsville, raising the Blue Streaks to great heights in District III during his tenure. His dual record was 331-115 in 30 years of coaching. Ken was a graduate of Hershey HS and West Chester University and served in the United States Navy. Ken is a member of several Halls of Fame, including the District III and Pennsylvania Coaches' halls as well as induction in both Hershey HS and Manheim Township HS halls.

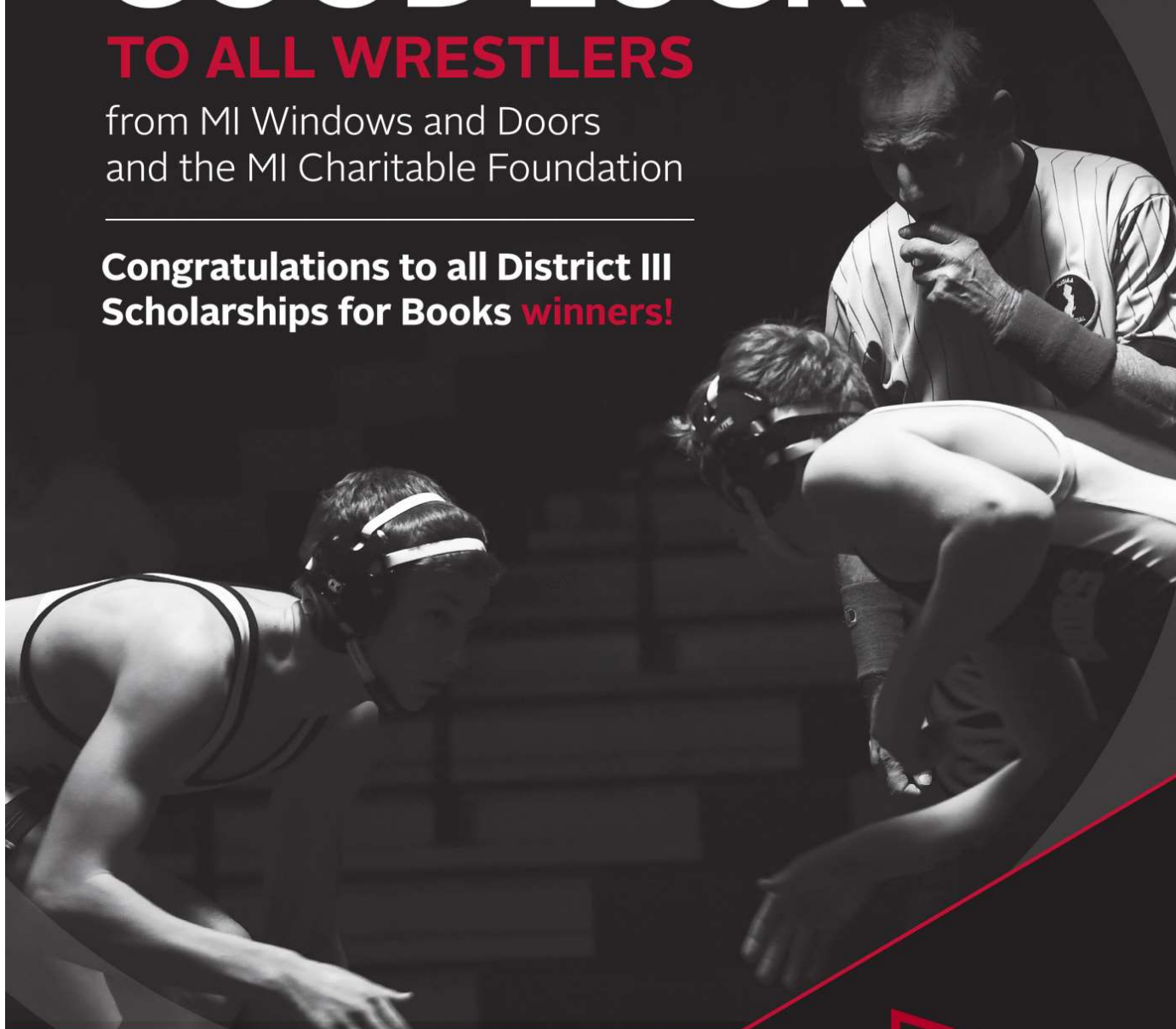

### Gettysburg—3A Champions

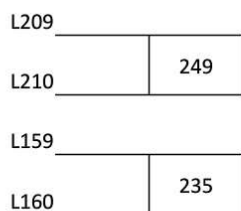
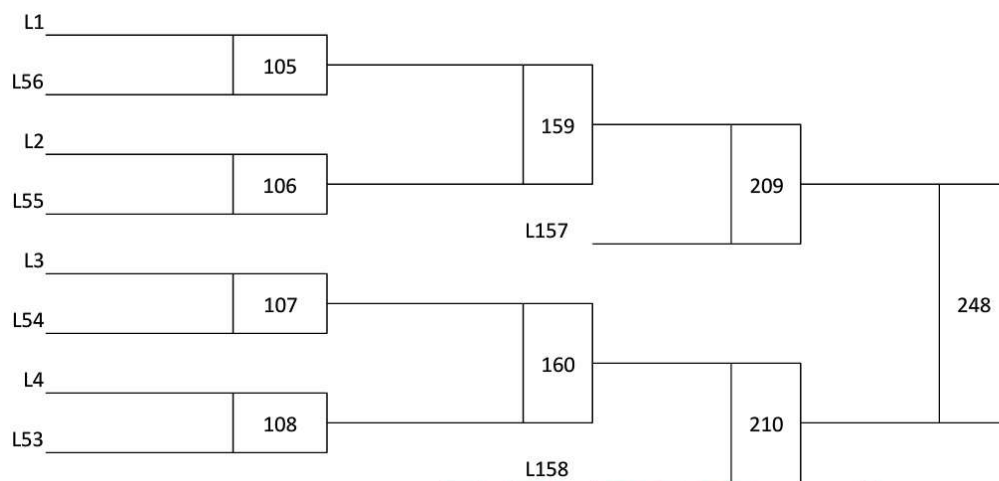

- ◆ The **E. Jerry Brooks Academic Excellence Medals** are awarded to student-athletes who have a minimum GPA of 3.8, participated in at least two varsity sports their senior year, earned a minimum of three varsity letters during their high school career, possess good citizenship and sportsmanship, and are recommended by the school's coaches and athletic director.
- ◆ The **Fackler-Hower Sportsmanship Medals** are awarded to one senior female and one senior male student-athlete at each District III high school. The winners are selected for demonstrating the most sportsman-like qualities throughout the year. In addition, the student-athletes must possess good citizenship and sportsmanship.

Jerry Brooks, Charles "Pete" Fackler and Wendell Hower were long-time members of the District III Committee. Mr. Brooks served the Committee for 18 years, 15 as Chairman. He was also a 15-year member of the State Board of Directors where he served as President and acting PIAA Executive Director. After retiring as principal at Penn Manor High School in 1984, Jerry was named District III's first executive director.

Mr. Fackler was a District III committee member for 20 years, 10 as Chairman. He was also a member of the State Board for 10 years. After retiring as principal at Hershey High School, he spent several years at Harrisburg Christian and served as executive director of the Commonwealth Christian Athletic Conference. He continues to serve District III as program coordinator.

Mr. Hower was a member of the District III Committee for 21 years, serving as its Secretary for 16 years. He became executive director from 1998-2019 and also served on the State Board. A long-time educator, he retired after a 29-year tenure as principal at Manheim Township High School.
