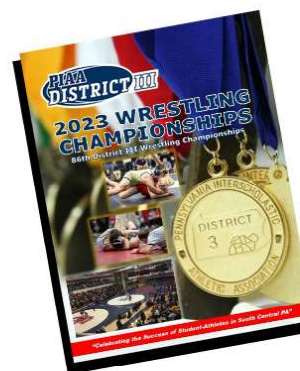

2023 DISTRICT III OFFICIAL PROGRAM

PIAA DISTRICT III

The state of Pennsylvania is divided in 12 geographic districts for PIAA administrative purposes. Each district has a district committee elected by member schools from within that District. Every committee elects a chairman who becomes that District's representative on the PIAA Board of Directors. District III has an additional representative on the State Board based on the number of members schools. District I and District XII also have an additional representative; District VII has two additional representatives.

District III encompasses the counties of Adams, Berks, Cumberland, Dauphin, Franklin, Juniata, Lancaster, Lebanon, Perry and York. Within this 10 county-area are 125 member senior high schools. These member schools elect their District Committee to oversee various interscholastic programs within the District. While the District Committee must follow all PIAA rules and regulations, each district has autonomy in administering athletic contests prior to the PIAA interdistrict level.

District III is home to the following leagues Berks County Interscholastic Athletic Association, Christian Commonwealth Athletic Conference, Lancaster-Lebanon League, Mid-Penn Conference, Tri-Valley League and York-Adams Interscholastic Athletic Association. A small number of schools retain independent status.

The voting rules of the District mandate that all leagues shall have at least one representative on the Committee as a voting member. These representatives are elected by the members schools at an Annual Meeting held each April. In addition, a representative from the Pennsylvania School Board Association, a male officials' representative, a female officials' representative, a male and a female parents' representative and a girls athletics representative stand as voting members of the District III committee. There are 16 voting members plus 12 non-voting members on the Committee.

The District Committee develops, organizes and directs 26 District III championships (13 for boys, 13 for girls) in 16 different sports. Broken down by gender and class, the District conducts 71 team championships and 30 individual championships. Among the 30 individual championships, the District crowns 168 champions each year. These championships are a prerequisite to qualification for PIAA championships. In the fall, these include boys and girls cross country, field hockey, boys and girls golf, football, boys and girls soccer, girls tennis and girls volleyball. In the winter, championships conducted are boys and girls basketball, boys and girls swimming & diving, wrestling and competitive spirit. While there is no PIAA championship for bowling, District III does conduct an individual championship for boys and girls bowling. The spring championships are baseball, boys and girls lacrosse, softball, boys and girls outdoor track and field, boys tennis and boys volleyball.

The cost of funding these championships comes primarily from the spectator ticket admission fees at District III playoff events. For sports where no admission fee is charged, schools pay a minimal entry fee per participant. Schools do not pay District dues. In years when the surplus is larger 50% of annual operating costs, the District will reimburse schools, either directly or by subsidizing their annual PIAA dues.

OUR MISSION

- ◆ Organize, develop and direct athletic programs that will promote the health and physical welfare of all participants, both male and female.
- ◆ Foster good sportsmanship and safeguard the educational values of interscholastic athletics.
- ◆ Develop and enforce rules adopted by the member schools that regulate interscholastic athletic competition.
- ◆ Organize and conduct a program of District III championship tournaments in various fields of athletic competition.

DISTRICT III WRESTLING HALL OF FAME Class of 2023

Jordan Enck



Inducted as a wrestler. Jordan is a 2008 graduate of Manheim Central High School and attended Hofstra University.

Jordan finished his high school wrestling career with 131 wins, setting a school record for most wins. He was a two-time Manheim Holiday Tournament champion, two-time King of the Mountain champion and Outstanding Wrestler in 2008, War on the Shore champion, and Times Leader Tournament champion. Jordan was a two-time Lancaster Lebanon league finalist and league champion, a four-time Sectional finalist, and two-time District III finalist and champion in 2008. Jordan qualified for

the PIAA AAA state tournament three times, and was the state runner-up in 2007 before capturing the state title in 2008. Jordan was ranked first in the nation at 215 pounds by Cliff Keen and Intermat. Jordan won multiple PA state Freestyle and Greco-Roman titles and was a member of the PA Freestyle and Greco-Roman dual team twice. Jordan was a two-time Fargo qualifier. Jordan was a member of the 2008 PA Dapper Dan team and defeated Tyrell Fortune 6-3. In college, Jordan wrestled as a starter at heavyweight his freshman year and placed second at the Colonial Athletic Association conference tournament in 2009. Jordan is USA wrestling bronze medal level coach. He is the Freestyle head coach at the Lancaster Alliance Wrestling Club and the assistant coach for Greco-Roman and folkstyle. Jordan is employed as a superintendent at Neal Enterprise's Professional Demolition Services. He lives in Mountville, PA with his girlfriend, Laura who has two sons, Casey who wrestles for Hempfield Junior High and Jorden who wrestles for Chartiers-Houston

Brad Kummerer



Inducted as a wrestler. Brad is a 2007 graduate of Hamburg Area High School and attended Lassen Community College.

Brad finished his high school wrestling career with 159 wins. He was a four-time Sectional champion, and four-time District III champion. Brad was a two time Regional champion. He was a four-time medalist in the PIAA AA state tournament, placing 7th, 8th, 4th, and 3rd respectively. Brad was named an All American wrestler by the National High School Coaches Association. In college, Brad was a state champion in the California Community College Athletic Association tournament, and a California All American.

Brad was inducted into the Hamburg Area School District Hall of Fame and the Berks County Wrestling Hall of Fame. Brad has served as an Assistant Coach at Hamburg Area High School since 2010.

Brad is a project manager with e4-Service. He lives in Hamburg, PA with his wife, Jessica, and two sons, Lincoln and Asher.

Bryant Meckley



Inducted as an official. Bryant is a 1971 graduate of Hanover High School and a 1975 graduate of Gettysburg College with a Bachelor's degree in Health and Exercise Science. He earned his Master's degree in Education from Western Maryland College in 1981 and his Doctorate from Immaculata University in 2010.

In high school, Bryant was a Sectional champion and Regional place winner. He wrestled at Gettysburg College, logging the most wins his junior year. After college, Bryant coached at Gettysburg High School from 1975 – 1983 where he coached several Sectional champions, District III place winners, and state place

winners.

Bryant has officiated high school wrestling since 1978 and has officiated at the college level for about 40 years. He has officiated numerous post season sectional and district tournaments including individual and team wrestling championships. He often served as head official at Regional tournaments. He has officiated at the PIAA State individual championships 7 times and at the team championship in 2002-03. At the college level, he has officiated numerous NCAA Division I and III qualifying tournaments. He was an official for the NCAA Division III championships four times and the NCAA Division II Championships once.

Bryant has served as the Rules Interpreter for the Greater York Wrestling Officials Chapter for over 20 years. He has been a member of the Executive Committee, the District III Wrestling Steering Committee and a PIAA convention speaker. In 2015, with Mike Settino and Joe Gessey, Bryant developed the metrics used to score and evaluate officials in District III. They presented that system to the PIAA convention in 2016.

Bryant is a retired high school school principal. He is an adjunct professor at McDaniel College and Mount Saint Mary's University. He lives in Hanover, PA with his wife Ann. They have three children, daughters Laura and Krista and son, Bryant, Jr and 6 grandchildren.

Joey was the PIAA AAA state champion in 2008 and the runner up in 2009. In college, Joey won 69 matches and was a three time NCAA Division I qualifier.

Joey is a mechanical engineer with Cleveland Cliffs, Inc. He lives in Monroe, Ohio with his wife, Lindsay, and two sons, Mitchell and Vincent.

Mike Settino



Inducted as an official. Mike is a 1977 graduate of Steelton- Highspire High School where he wrestled for Nick Govelich and finished his senior year 15-3. Mike’s post-season was cut short by an injury that ended his wrestling career after his freshman year on the varsity team at Keystone College.

Mike served as an official for 31 years. He officiated the District III individual finals 19 times and the team championship finals 3 times. In total, Mike officiated 25 District III individual tournaments and 27 Sectional tournaments. As a District III Wrestling Official, he was ranked in the Top Ten 14 times and the Top 25 24 times.

Mike served as the Mid-Penn Officials Assigner for 12 years, and currently is the post-season Officials Assignor for District III. He was the Harrisburg Chapter Rules Interpreter for 5 years and the Chapter Secretary for 25 years. In 2015, with Bryant Meckley and Joe Gessey, Mile developed the metrics used to score and evaluate officials in District III. They presented that system to the PIAA convention in 2016. Mike currently compiles all metrics from the coaches and officials and prepares the data for the final District III ranking.

Mike is the author of a novel, Wave Rider, a dystopian science fiction work published in 2020. He currently lives in Hummelstown, PA with his wife of 35 years, Denise. They have two daughters, Meghan, a data analyst, and Alyson, a kindergarten teacher.

Mallie Shuster



Inducted as a wrestler. Mallie is a 2008 graduate of Big Spring High School. Mallie attended Kent State University where he earned a Bachelor’s degree in Interdisciplinary Studies in 2012, and he received his MBA from Shippensburg University in 2021.

Mallie finished his high school wrestling career with 153 wins. He was a four-time champion at the Carlisle Christmas tournament where he was named Outstanding Wrestler three times. He was a two-time Escape the Rock champion and a three-time Beast of the East place winner. Mallie was a three-time Sectional champion, three-time District III champion, and three-time PIAA AAA state medalist. Mallie was the 2008 PIAA AAA champion at 152 lbs. He was a member of two Big Spring Mid-Penn Colonial champion teams in 2005 and 2008.

In college, Mallie was a three-time letter winner, MAC male scholar athlete of the week in February 2010. He was named to the Academic All-MAC team twice (2009-10 and 2011-2012) and the NWCA All-Academic Team in 2011-12. Mallie ranked as high as 20th by D1 College Wrestling and was a 2012 NCAA Division I qualifier. Mallie was a member of the 2011-12 Kent State team which won the outright MAC regular conference championship with a 5 – 0 conference dual record.

Mallie is an assistant coach at Shippensburg High School, and an instructor at Tactical Combat Academy of Mixed Martial Arts in Greencastle, PA.

Mallie is employed in operations and marketing for Newville Construction Services and East Coast Access. He lives in Newville, PA with his wife, Aimee.

Tony Yaniello



Inducted as a coach. Tony is a 1971 graduate of Towanda High School where he lettered in wrestling, track, football and cross country. Tony attended Keystone College where he was a two-time letterman in wrestling and team captain under the legendary Larry Fornicola. He graduated from Penn State University in 1977 where he was a varsity letterman under coach Bill Koll.

Tony’s career record as head varsity wrestling coach was 261-161-2. Tony was head coach at Tyrone from 1979 to 1999. His career record at Tyrone was 158-115-2 which is the most wins by any Tyrone coach. At Tyrone, Tony won the first District individual team championship and the first regional individual team championship. Tony coached 21 District VI champions, six regional champions, and 3 state champions, along with multiple state place winners. Tony’s teams won 3 District VI individual team championships and one regional championship. In the 1982-83 season, his team finished 5th in the state with 6 qualifiers. Tony’s teams earned a top 10 ranking seven times. Tony was the head coach at Shippensburg High School from 2000 to 2010 with over 100 dual meet wins, 4 District III Champions, and 7 PIAA AAA State Place winners. In 2016-17, Shippensburg qualified for the 1st time for the District team duals championships, losing a tight battle to the eventual champions from Exeter in the semi-finals.

Tony was voted coach of the year 3 times and was inducted in the District VI Hall of Fame in 2005. He served as PIAA District VI AA individual tournament director, District VI AAA assistant director, the District VI Team Duals tournament director and the Southwest Regional AA assistant tournament director. In 2000 Tony ran the last AA vs AAA Challenge of Champions. Tony served as president of the District VI Coaches Association for 2 years. Tony currently lives in Chambersburg, PA.

IN MEMORIUM EARL HOFFMAN



Earl E. Hoffman, who established the wrestling program at Mechanicsburg HS to great success, passed away at the age of 93 on October 2, 2022.

Mr. Hoffman is well-known for his many years of excellence not only as a coach, official and contributor to the sport, but also as a devout Christian who devoted his life in service to others.

Mr. Hoffman was the 1947 District 3 wrestling champion at 120 pounds for Hershey HS. He reached the semifinals of the 1947 PIAA Wrestling Championships but was forced to default after re-aggravating an injury.

He graduated from West Chester State Teachers College and enlisted in the Marine Corps, where he coached wrestling before receiving his honorable discharge at the rank of Captain.

He began teaching at Mechanicsburg in 1955, starting the wrestling program at the behest of the administration. His first team, consisting of wrestlers with no experience – most had never seen a match – finished 5 -4 and triggered an amazing record of 80-1 over the next seven years.

Mr. Hoffman has received numerous honors and is a member of several wrestling halls of fame: District 3 Wrestling Coaches Association (1977), Pa. Wrestling Coaches Association (1979), Pa. Chapter National Wrestling Hall of Fame (2011).

Mr. Hoffman was preceded in his passing by his wife of 65 years, Barbara, who passed just 6 weeks before Earl. He is survived by sons Randy and Rick, 10 grandchildren and 12 great-grandchildren.
