Weigh-Ins: Saturday, March 2, 2024 at 9:00 AM- You must be on time Weigh-ins by weight will start on time. There will be four scales in the Auxiliary Gym.

Coaches Meeting: Located in the LGI: 9:40 AM (3/2)

# <u>All qualified wrestlers and coaches will enter the building at a separate entrance at the back of the school. Coach's Bands will be provided per team upon entry.</u>

\*Extra team personnel (managers, teammates, & photographers) are not allowed on the competition floor area at any time.

**Medical Personnel:** Penn Manor will provide athletic trainers and a doctor. All teams should bring their own medical kit with them. If your team requires taping/wrapping, please make sure your athletic trainer reaches out to Kelly McNeal (<u>kelly.mcneal@pennmanor.net</u>) ahead of time.

Cheerleaders: No cheerleaders will be permitted mat-side and will not receive free admission.

**Awards:** Medals will be awarded to the top four wrestlers in each weight class. Top four advance to the PIAA State Tournament. 5th/6th place matches will be wrestled to determine alternates but will not be awarded medals.

Team Champion: Point system recommended by the NFHS/PIAA.

Programs: PIAA-District III Programs available on-line (District III site).

Parking: Spectators will use the parking deck in the back of the school.
Buses will be directed on where to park in the bus lanes.
Team vans will park at the back of the school by the back participant entrance.
All athletes and coaches will have an athlete entrance at the back of the school. (see map)

Mats: All rounds will be run on 3 mats

Concessions: Concession stand located above the cafeteria.

Locker Rooms: Monitored locker rooms will be available upon arrivals for athletes to change. Athletes MUST bring their valuables out of the locker room once they are changed. Penn Manor is not responsible for any lost or stolen items.

**Wrestlers:** NO GYM BAGS WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE MAIN SEATING AREA OF THE GYMNASIUM. There will be assigned team 'camp' areas in the cafeteria.

**Hospitality Room:** Coaches Hospitality is above the cafeteria across from the gym and will be open prior to the start of weigh-ins and remain open until the end of the day. There will be food provided throughout the day.

### **Fans:** Doors open at approx. **9:00 AM** All fans must watch from the bleachers and not inside the roped off areas.

**Warm-up area:** There will be a designated warm-up area in the auxiliary gym for wrestlers to warm-up. We ask that wrestlers use that space and not be in the competition area for warming up. Two mats will be present in the warm-up area.
